

Once prompted on the next screen you will be required to enter your email address (this must be the email registered at the school) and a student code (this will be provided by your school). 

This is the main page of the Parent Portal. On this page you will see recent messages, student summaries and upcoming events. You can return to this page at any time by clicking



## My Messages



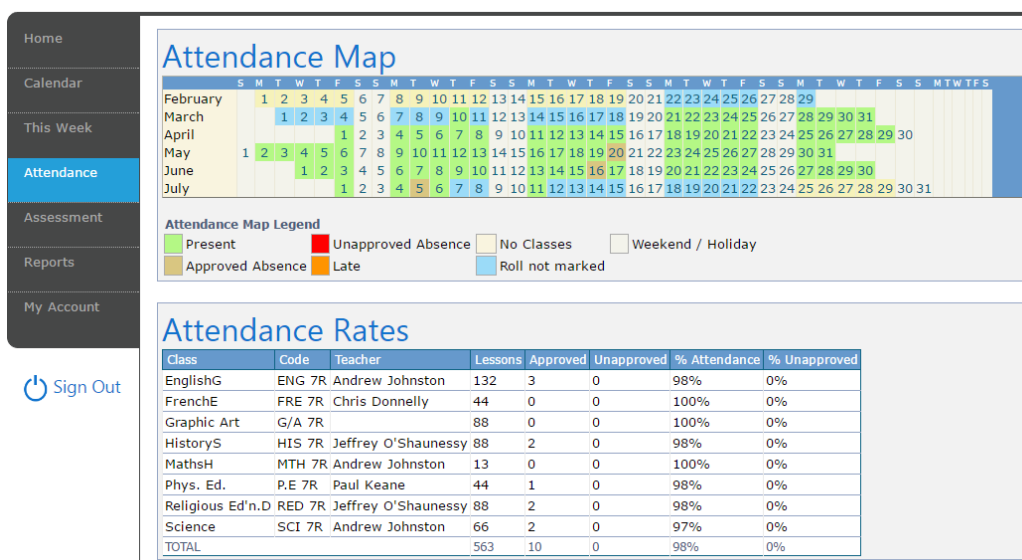

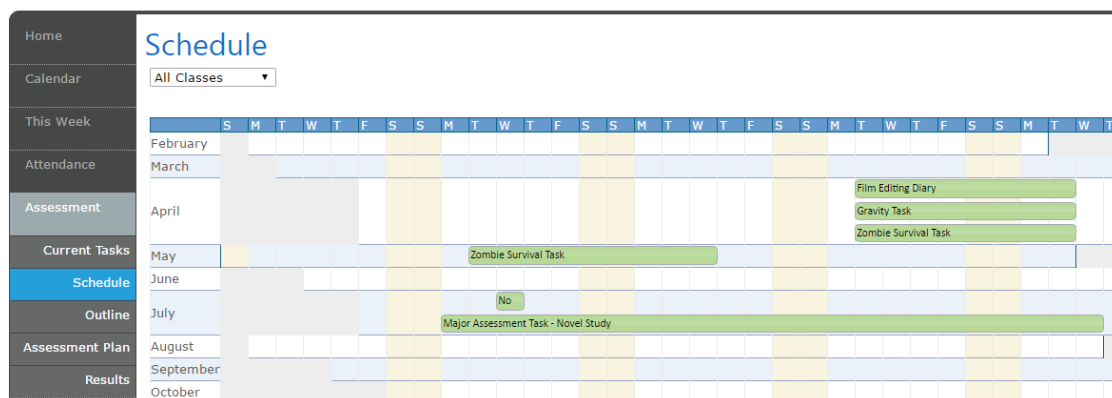
