**RE: ARRANGEMENTS FOR LEARNING AT HOME AND LEARNING ON SITE**

This letter is to inform you of changes to our learning program at Valley View Secondary School.

As advised by the Minister for Education and following public health advice, all schools will remain open this week and will be closed next week for 4 pupil free days.

During this time, families have made informed decisions about whether or not to send their child to school or to support them to learn from home.

- From **30 March -3 April (Week 10)** it is assumed that all children will be attending school. However, should you decide to keep them at home, there is an expectation that you keep us informed of the reason for your child's absence.
- From **6 April – 9 April (Week 11)** the school will be **CLOSED** for 4 Pupil Free Days. During the 4 pupil free days, teachers will be preparing on-line learning programs and resources to support students to access learning remotely
- **Monday 27 April – Student Free Day**
- From **28 April (Term 2)** Valley View Secondary School will remain **OPEN** for any family that wishes for their children to Learn on Site

- Learn on Site
